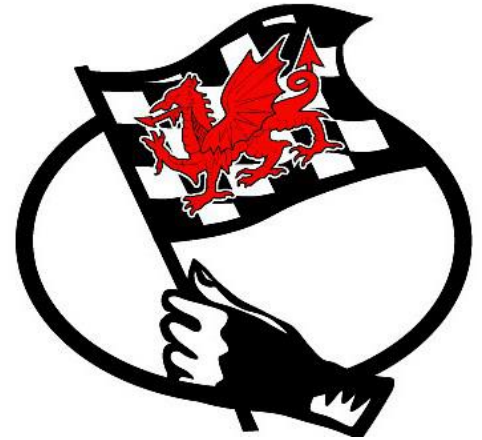
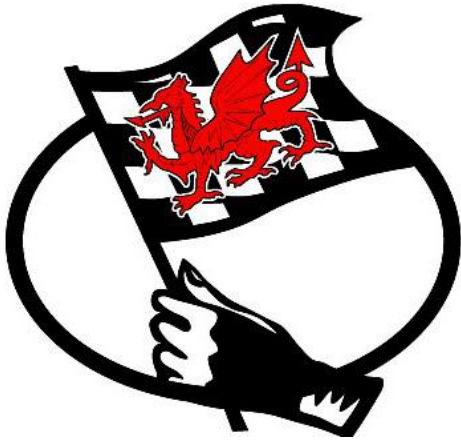

PRODUCTION CAR AUTOTEST



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1) Tregaron and District Motorclub will promote a Clubman's Production Car Autotest on 12th September 2021 at *Hendre Stone Ltd, Ystrad Meurig, Ceredigion SY25 6DB*
- 2) The meeting will be governed under the General Regulations of The MotorSport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
- 3) MotorSport UK Clubman Permit *122803* and will be on display on the day.
- 4) The event is run under a clubman's permit and only open to members of Tregaron and District Motorclub.
- 5) Entries will NOT be accepted on the day.
- 6) Entries will open *Sunday 29th at 21:00* and close *Thursday 9th at 20:00*. The maximum number of entries will be 30. This will be on a first come first served basis. You will get an email when your entry is received and confirmed.
- 7) Signing on will commence at 08:30am, scrutineering at 08:30am, driver briefing at 09:15am and first test to begin at 09:30am. Any competitor not signed on by 09:10am will not be running
- 8) All competitors, drivers and passengers must be a member of Tregaron and District Motorclub. All competitors, drivers and passengers must hold a valid Motorsport UK RS Clubman license. The Motorsport UK RS Clubman license is free of charge and can be applied for online at www.motorsportuk.org. This must be done prior to the. Applications for licenses or membership will NOT be accepted on the day.

- 9) Entries will be accepted from a minimum age of 14 year old. However any entries accepted from 14, 15 or 16 year olds or if you don't hold a full RTA license, the passenger **MUST** hold a full RTA license and be experienced in Autotesting and car must not exceed 2000cc. Parents or guardians of any competitor under 18 years old must complete all relevant paperwork.
- 10) Open top cars **MUST** either have a hard top fitted at all times or half cage fitted in the rear.
- 11) The event will consist of three classes as follows:
Front wheel Drive and
Rear Wheel Drive.
Under 17
- 12) No Competitor may win more than one award.
Awards as follows:-
1st Overall
1st Front Wheel Drive, Rear Wheel Drive and Under 17
2nd Front Wheel Drive, Rear Wheel Drive and Under 17
3rd Front Wheel Drive, Rear Wheel Drive and Under 17

- 13) Penalties are as follows -
 - Time taken completing the course = Actual time taken
 - Striking a cone or barrier or any other course marker = 5 seconds per offence
 - Failure to stop astride the stop line = 20 seconds
 - Taking an incorrect route on any course (Wrong Test) = Maximum Time
 - Completing a test in a time exceeding the maximum - Maximum time slowest time of that course, plus 30 seconds. If a driver returns to the point of their mistake, and then completes the test correctly, a wrong test does not apply.
- 14) Each driver will have two or more runs at each layout and all test times will count
- 15) Timing will be by hand held stopwatches to the previous tenth of a second.
- 16) Competitors will start in their own time upon clearance from the timekeeper.
- 17) Timing will start when the front wheels cross the Timing line.
- 18) Timing will stop when the front wheels stop astride the stop line.
- 19) In the event of a tie the fastest run of the first course will determine the tie, and then the fastest on the second course, etc until the tie is resolved.

- 20) To be classified as a finisher, competitors must start at least one run at all courses.
- 21) Practicing will not be allowed.
- 22) Any competitor performing handbrake turns off course and surrounding areas will be excluded from the event.
- 23) All details of tests will be available when you have signed on.
- 24) Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers. In the event of sharing a vehicle it is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct number on display. Failure in doing this you may not get your correct time.
- 25) The event will be held under Motorsport UK Covid-19 Guidance. We ask for you to familiarize yourself with the Motorsport UK Competitors Guidance www.motorsportuk.org
- 26) Results will be posted 30 minutes after the last car has finished the final test, followed by the presentation of the awards.
